Dr. Nóbrega is currently a Senior Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School for Business and Government and was previously a Visiting Scholar at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government (2009) and at the Harvard Law School (2007-2008). He is an Associate Professor of Administrative Law at the Federal University of Pernambuco in Brazil and is also a member of the Pernambuco State Court of Audit. He has authored books and articles on infrastructure and is currently analyzing the role of public-private partnerships in the World Cup (2014) and in the Olympic Games (2016) that will take place in Brazil.
