Lorenzo Preve is an associate professor at the Finance Department at IAE, Universidad Austral. He joined the department in 1998.

Professor Preve holds a PhD in Finance from the University of Texas at Austin (May 2004). Before, he obtained an Executive MBA (Magna cum Laude) at IAE, Universidad Austral, and a BA from the Universidad Católica Argentina.

His research topics are mainly focused in empirical corporate finance, more specifically, corporate risk management, working capital management, trade credit, financial distress, corporate restructuring, and capital structure. He has also a special interest in corporate finance in emerging markets. His papers have been presented in international conferences and seminars, and have been published in the *Journal of Financial Economics*, the *Financial Management*, and the *Journal of Applied Corporate Finance*. He is the author of three books and several articles and case studies. Professor Preve serves as a referee for academic journals and conferences.

He teaches in the Masters and Executive Education Programs at IAE Business School, Universidad Austral in Buenos Aires, where he is also the Head of the Finance Department. He visited universities in the USA, Chile, Colombia, Uruguay, Perú and Ecuador.

He obtained a Fulbright Scholarship, the University of Texas at Austin Bruton Fellowship, and was nominated by the Finance Department of the University of Texas at Austin for the Fred Moore Assistant Instructor Teaching Excellence Award, and for the Continuing Fellowship. He was recently awarded with the FONDECYT Scholarship for the paper Trade Receivables Policy of Distressed Firms and its Effect on the Cost of Financial Distress (joint with Carlos A. Molina).

Before joining academia Lorenzo worked for investment banks, corporations and as an independent consultant in the mergers and acquisitions and advisory services. He currently complements his academic work with appointments as a consultant for several industrial corporations and service firms.
