He also served as Coordinator of Negotiations and Administration of Agreements on Technical Barriers to Trade, having participated as a specialist and negotiator of Peru in different processes and forums such as the World Trade Organization (WTO), the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation Forum (APEC), the Latin American Integration Association (ALADI), the Andean Community (CAN) and bilateral negotiations with the United States, Chile, Mexico, Singapore, Canada, China, the European Free Trade Association (EFTA), the European Union, Korea and Japan.

Prior to joining the public sector, Mr. Vásquez was Head of Economic Studies at the consulting firm Maximixe, being responsible of the economic advisory service department and macroeconomic and sectorial analysis and projections.
