Since July 2016, Miguel Berger is Director General of Economic Affairs and Sustainable Development at the Federal Foreign Office. One of his major stages since starting to work at the Foreign Ministry in 1990 was his position as Head of the representative office in the Palestinian Territories. From 2010 to 2012 he was Deputy Head at the Permanent Mission of Germany to the United Nations in New York and member of the United Nations Security Council in 2011 and 2012. At the Federal Foreign Office, he was Head of the Parliamentary and Cabinet Council, and held the position as Commissioner for Global Issues as well as for External Energy and Climate Policy. Before returning to the Economic Department at the end of July, he was Regional Commissioner for the Near and Middle East as well as the Maghreb.
