

Henning Vöpel has been director and CEO of the Hamburg Institute of International Economics (HWWI) since 2014. In 2010, Vöpel was appointed Professor for Economics at the HSBA Hamburg School of Business Administration. His main research areas are business cycle analysis, fiscal and monetary policy and digital economy.

After studying economics at the University of Hamburg, Prof. Vöpel received his doctorate in 2004 with a thesis on the "Stabilizing Effects of Monetary Policy".

In 2006, Professor Vöpel took part twice in the joint economic forecast of the leading economic research institutes on behalf of the German government. In 2009, at the invitation of the US Department of State, he spent a research stay in Washington D.C., San Francisco, and Boston as part of the International Leadership Program.

Prof. Vöpel is chairman of the scientific advisory board of the BVMW Federal Association of Medium-Sized Enterprises. Vöpel also hosts a television program, co-hosts a podcast and co-founded the Hammerbrooklyn Digital Campus.
