



"Hydrogen - where are we?"

Hydrogen is currently regarded as the most promising solution on our way to further decarbonization of industry. The idea is not new. What has changed, however, compared to earlier efforts to get production and technology off the ground, are the framework conditions: There are clear commitments on both the political and the business side. Germany announced its hydrogen strategy in summer 2020. For the EU hydrogen is a key element of its Green Deal. And also in Latin America countries like Chile are in the process of creating concrete structures and framework conditions for the production of green hydrogen. With its high share of "renewables", some existing projects and the plan to become the world's largest producer of green hydrogen by 2030, the Andean country is playing a pioneering role in the region. But where do we stand exactly in the development of (green) hydrogen? Also, the question of the state of the art of the technology arises in addition to production. Which hydrogen projects are already in operation? What are the experiences? When will the hydrogen-fueled vehicles dominate the roads in Germany/Europe? And what does this development look like in Chile/Latin America?
